## MEMORADUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding made and executed between:

The POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES – Sta. Mesa Campus, a non-stock, non-profit educational institution, duly recognized and Philippine laws with office address at Anonas Street, Barangay 630, Sta. Mesa, Maniia, represented herein by ADAM V. RAMILO, MIR, Vice President for hereinafter referred to as "UNIVERSITY".

The MANILA HEALTH DEPARTMENT, ESPERANZA HEALTH CENTER, a public health center under the auspice of the city government of Manila located at Teresa Street, Sta. Mesa, Manila under the direct supervision of DR. JULIUS P. MANALAD, a government physician who is duly authorized to represent it under this agreement and hereinafter referred to as "ESPERANZA HEALTH CENTER".

The parties hereby bind themselves to undertake a Memorandum of Understanding for the purpose of providing the University's referral system in addressing our students and employees/stakeholders with health issues particularly this time in Covid-19 pandemic.

Under the following terms and conditions:

- 1. In the event that any of the University students and employees in Sta. Mesa Campuses have a Covid-19 like symptoms, he/she may be referred to the above stated health center for assistance in referral to Covid-19 testing facility, Temporary Treatment Management Facility (TTMF), Barangay Health Emergency Response Team (BHERT) services, likewise be provided with other available health services and coordination with other local government unit, when necessary.
- This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective upon signature of both parties and implementation will begin immediately and shall continue to be effective until written notice is given by either party within thirty (30) days prior to the date of intended termination.

Now, whereof, for and in consideration of the above premise and of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties do hereby mutually agree within the limits of the laws governing their respective existence.
